Obedience: **-Primary** (members in K-2nd grade)
 -Pre-Novice A (1st year members only & former aged out primaries now entering 3rd grade)
 -Pre-Novice B
 -Novice
 -Advanced Novice
 -Graduate Novice
 -Open
 -Graduate Open
 -Utility

Standard Agility: **-Elementary**
 -Pre-Novice
 -Novice
 -Open
 -Excellent

Jumpers Agility: **-Pre-Novice** – Jumpers without weaves
 -Novice – Jumpers with weaves
 -Open – Jumpers with weaves
 -Excellent – Jumpers with weaves

Rally: **-Novice**
 -Advanced A
 -Advanced B
 -Excellent

Ask your leader if you are unsure on which classes to list.

Access to a Dog

Each member is expected to have access to one or more dogs. This means a member may borrow, rent, or lease a dog for a project. This should be indicated in the 4-H Record Book. The dog **MUST** be under the 4-H member's care and training at least 60 days before a qualifying show. Two members may share a dog as their 4-H project. There must be an agreement in each member's record about the shared dog. However, the two members may not show the dog in the same class(es). Ask your leader if you have any questions.
